We are a community-based charity started by a group of local Mums in 2013. We gather donations of new and pre-loved baby and children's clothes, toys and equipment for local families in need. The demand for our service is everincreasing.

We have a core team of volunteers who are busy sorting, safety-checking and preparing items ready for distribution, but we always need help and that's where you come in.

What to expect on the day

Our sessions usually run from 9:30am – 1:30pm, with

- a 30 minute refreshment break.
- The first task of the day is always a cuppa,
- followed by a briefing session.
 Tasks will vary, but the main bulk of our work is organising, checking and preparing donations.
 Expect to get stuck into these jobs, from safety checking prams to ensuring puzzles have no missing pieces!
- We want your day to be as rewarding as possible. A dedicated trained member of staff will be guiding your team throughout the day.
- We also run **seasonal campaigns** which may require your help as needed. These are great fun to be involved in and we often find that volunteers like to come back year after year to help.
