
WHO ARE STRIPEY STORK AND WHAT DO WE DO

At our warehouses in Reigate and second site in Redhill, we recycle, restore and rehome the items local families have outgrown and gift them to the most vulnerable families in our community, supporting a circular economy in a focused and meaningful way. Local families helping local families.

Stripey Stork receives requests for support on behalf of families in need from a wide range of referral partners and organisations – social workers, health visitors, schools & nurseries, family centres, food banks, women's refuges, midwives and nurses. We collect new and pre-loved items for babies, children and teenagers up to the age of eighteen. These items include clothing, shoes, school uniform, school bags & equipment, moses baskets & cots, equipment for babies, toiletries, toys and books.

We have a core team of volunteers who sort, organise, safety-check and prepare all these items, so they are readily available to be distributed to families in need. A hard-working team of corporate volunteers can truly make a significant impact to our daily tasks, enabling Stripey Stork to quickly respond to the needs of the hundreds of families we support each week.

Corporate partnerships are key to Stripey Stork being able to deliver the lifeline service we are recognised for. We have dedicated members of staff who manage these alliances, we offer a hands-on approach and work closely with our partners to ensure we develop a mutually beneficial relationship.

WHAT TO EXPECT ON THE DAY

Our sessions run from 9:30am – 1:30pm, with a half hour refreshment break, on a Monday, Wednesday and Thursday

We can accommodate **up to 12 people**. This group size ensures each volunteer benefits from a productive session.

We will begin with **an introductory talk** about our work, explain how we operate and deliver our service.

A dedicated member of staff will provide a briefing and guide your group throughout the session, to ensure every member of your team has a rewarding and meaningful volunteering experience.

We'll aim to introduce one of our referral partners who'll explain a little about the families they are currently working with and how Stripey Stork is providing help.

Tasks will vary, but the main bulk of our work is organising, checking and preparing donations.

At our Reigate warehouse, your team will support our year-round Core Service. Tasks include ensuring that donated clothing is in excellent condition, equipment is in perfect working order and toys have passed our safety-checks before any of these items can be incorporated into our referral packages

At our second site, your team will support our School Days initiative by sorting and preparing donations of uniform, alongside the additional items a child needs for their school day. They will also help with our seasonal campaigns, including preparing Christmas gift bundles for our Santa Stork campaign in November and December




WHAT WE ASK OF YOU


OTHER USEFUL INFORMATION

Our **Reigate premise** is located at 51a Albert Road North, Reigate, RH2 9EL. There is parking available on site. We are a 12 minute walk from Reigate station.

Our **Redhill site** is located at Raven House, 29 Linkfield Lane, Redhill, RH1 1SS. There is limited parking available in designated spaces on site and additional parking in nearby public car parks. We are a 10 minute walk from Redhill station.

OUR CANCELLATION POLICY



Our Cancellation Policy supports our service by ensuring our volunteer schedule runs smoothly and our productivity is not affected by unforeseen gaps in our income and volunteer support.

It is not uncommon for Stripey Stork to support more than 200 families in one week and therefore every hour spent volunteering is critical to our operation.

We ask for a minimum financial contribution of £350 for a group of up to 12 people. This donation allows Stripey Stork to resource your session appropriately, with a trained member of our team, who will guide your group throughout the day. This payment is due four weeks before your booking.

TERMS OF CANCELLATION



We understand that commitments can change. If you would like to reschedule your visit, we will do our best to accommodate your request, provided it is submitted at least four weeks before your original booking date and subject to the availability in our bookings calendar.



If you cancel your booking with less than four weeks' notice, our £350 invoice will still be due.
