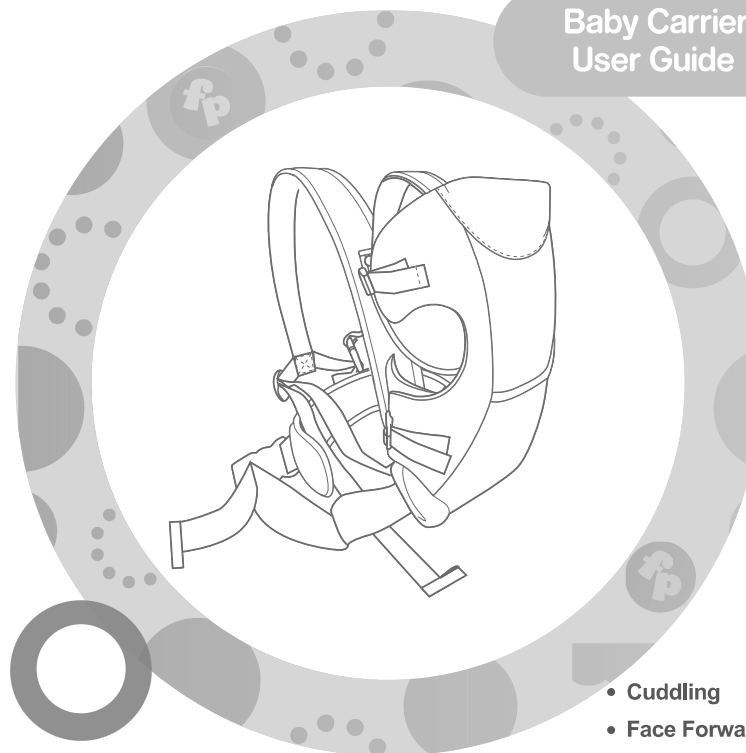

- When taking out or putting in the baby, please make sure you do this in a safe place and bend yourself down.
- Your balance may be adversely affected by your movement and that of your child
- Take care when bending or leaning forward
- This carrier is not suitable for use during sporting activities

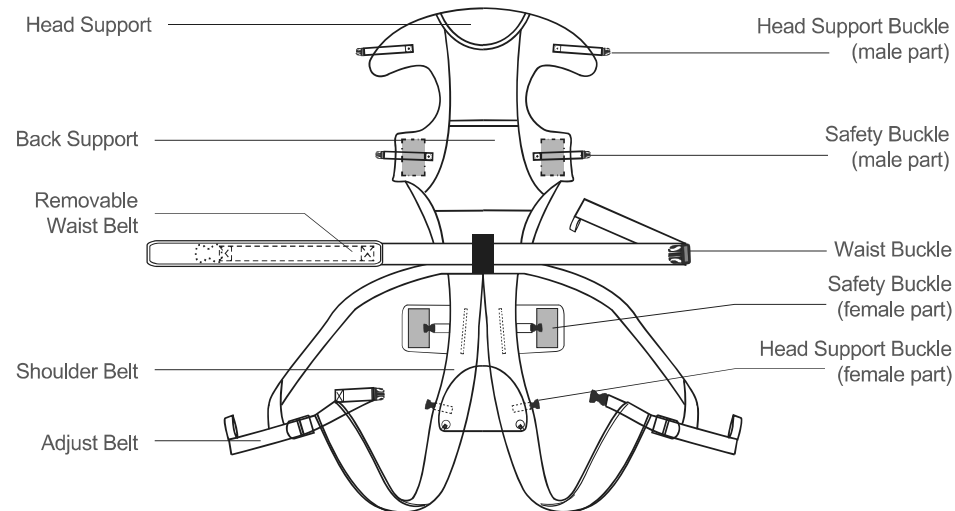
Notice

- Never release the lines behind the safety belt.

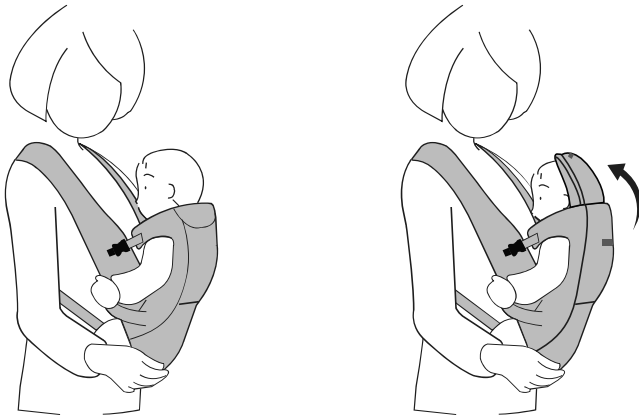

Instructions for head support and leg adjustment



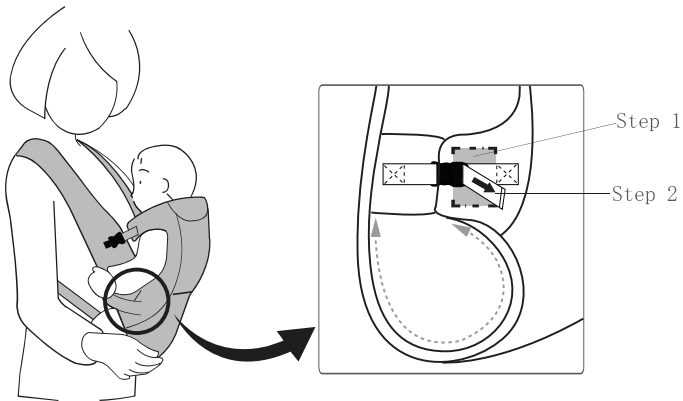
- Confirmed
- Head support used in a common way
- Head support used as a sunshade



Remove the fastener and turn head support inward to appropriate position

- Adjustment for leg opening



Step 1 Adjust the fastener to a suitable size for baby's leg

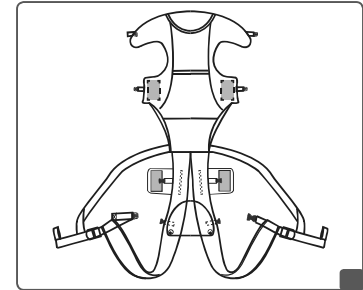
Step 2 Fix the buckle and adjust the webbing to optimum position

Preparation for use

Assembly

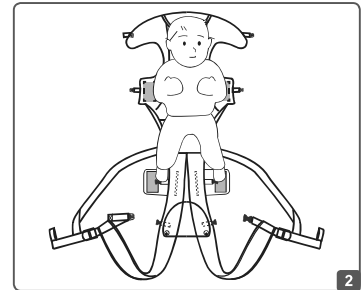
Step 1

Open carrier at a safe place.



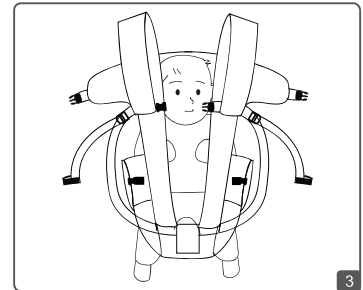
Step 2

Put the baby on the carrier.



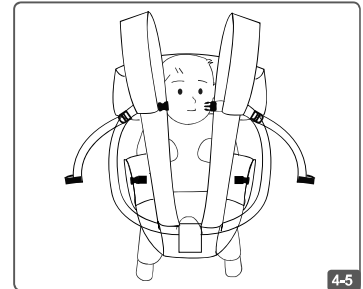
Step 3

Fold the stomach pad and put on the baby's stomach.



Step 4

Click the buckle into the male parts on the stomach pad.



Step 5

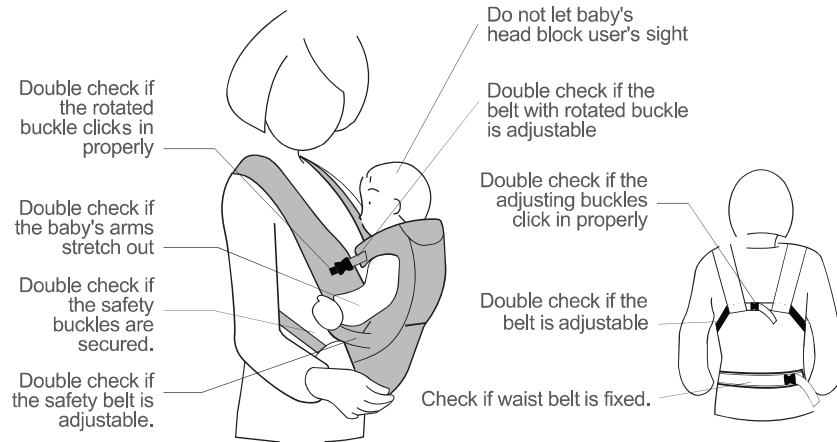
Put 2 or 3 adult fingers in between the carrier and baby and adjust belt length. Adjust the left and right belt to the same length.

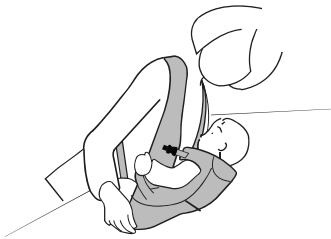

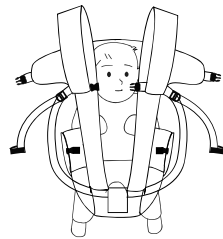

1. Put down the baby in a safe place, and take off the shoulder belt from user's shoulder.



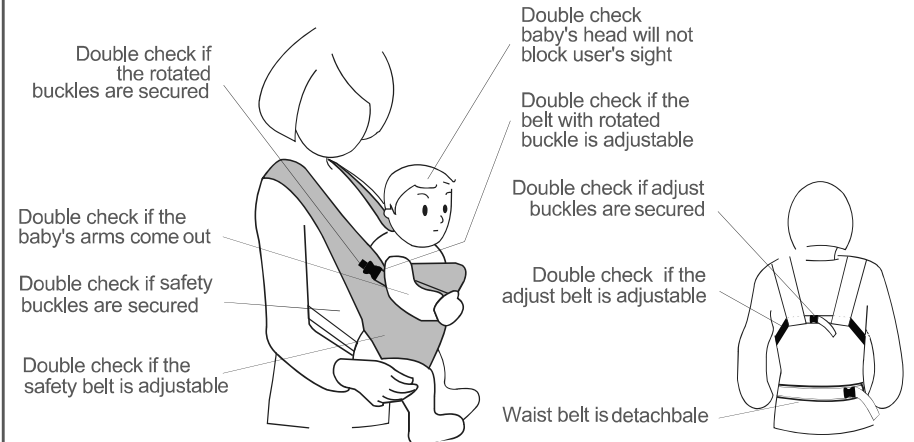
2. Release the buckles on stomach pad, take the baby out

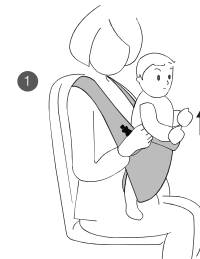

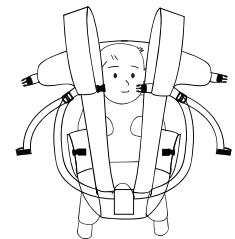

2. Release safety buckles then take the baby out.

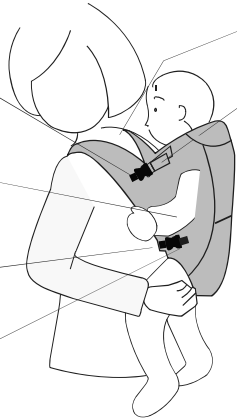

Double check if the rotated buckles are secured

Double check if the baby's arms come out

Double check if the safety buckles are secured

Double check if the safety belt is adjustable



Double check if the top of baby's head reaches the same height of the user's shoulders

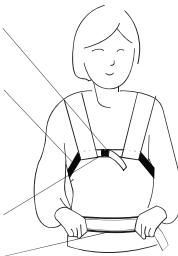
Double check if the belt with rotated buckle is adjustable

Double check if the adjusted buckles are secured

Double check if the belt is adjustable

Double check if the end of the shoulder belt is fixed by the elastic ring

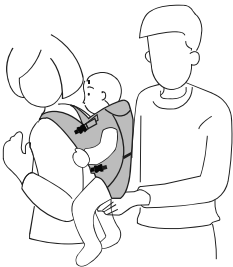
Waist belt is detachable



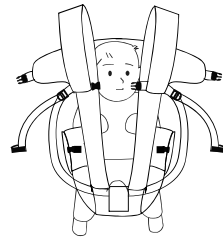

Take off the carrier -- A third party aid is necessary if there is any problem doing it alone



1. Let some else support the baby, take off the shoulder belt from user's shoulders.



2. Release the safety buckles, then take the baby out.
