Poverty affects the way children feel, how they learn, how they grow and develop, and the relationships they have. Stripey Stork transform the lives of children experiencing poverty by providing the practical items they need, to give them the best possible chance to reach developmental milestones, embrace their potential and enjoy their childhood. We recycle, restore and rehome the items local families have outgrown and gift them to the most vulnerable families in our community, supporting a circular economy in a focused and meaningful way.

Local families helping local families.

Stripey Stork receives requests for support on behalf of families in need from a wide range of referral partners and organisations – social workers, health visitors, schools and nurseries, family centres, food banks, women's refuges, midwives and nurses. We collect new and pre-loved items for babies, children and teenagers up to the age of eighteen. These items include clothing, shoes, school uniform, school bags and school equipment, moses baskets and cots, equipment for babies, nappies and wipes, toiletries, toys and books.

It is not uncommon for Stripey Stork to provide help for more than 300 families each week and we have a core team of volunteers who sort, organise, safety-check and prepare donated items, so they are readily available to be distributed to families in need. A hard-working team of corporate volunteers can make a significant and immediate impact, enabling Stripey Stork to quickly respond to the needs of the hundreds of children we support each week.

DEVELOP YOUR CSR PROGRAMME

We can tailor our volunteering offering to suit your requirements and help deliver your CSR targets, from one-off volunteering team days to developing a programme of activity to take place throughout the year. WHAT TO EXPECT ON THE DAY

- ★ Our sessions run from 9:30am – 1:30pm on a Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, across our two sites.
- ★ We kindly ask for a minimum financial contribution of £500 **for a group of up to 12 people**. This income provides vital funds to support our continued operation.
- ★ We will begin with an **introductory talk** about our service and what can be accomplished when we work together.
- ★ A member of our team will then provide a briefing and be **present to support your group throughout the session**, to ensure every member of your team has a fulfilling and meaningful volunteering experience.
- ★ We'll aim to **introduce one of our referral partners** who'll explain a little about the families they are working with and how Stripey Stork is providing help.
- ★ Tasks will vary, but the main bulk of our work is **organising, checking and preparing donations**.



At our warehouse, your team will support our year-round core service.

Tasks include ensuring that donated clothing is in excellent condition, equipment is in perfect working order and toys have passed our safety-checks before any of these items can be included in our referral packages



At our project site, your team will support our School Days initiative; by sorting and preparing bundles of uniform and the additional items a child needs to embrace every aspect of their school day. In November and December our corporate volunteers support our Santa Stork campaign by preparing Christmas gift bundles

Our **Reigate warehouse** is located at 51a Albert Road North, Reigate, RH2 9EL. There is parking available on site. We are a 12 minute walk from Reigate station.

Our **Redhill site** is located at Raven House, 29 Linkfield Lane, Redhill, RH1 1SS. There is limited parking available in designated spaces on site and additional parking in nearby public car parks. We are a 10 minute walk from Redhill station.

OUR CANCELLATION POLICY



Our Cancellation Policy supports our service by ensuring our volunteering schedule runs smoothly and our productivity is not affected by unforeseen gaps in our income and volunteer support.

It is not uncommon for Stripey Stork to support more than 300 families in one week and therefore every hour spent volunteering is critical to our operation.

We kindly ask for a minimum financial contribution of £500 for a group of up to 12 people. This donation allows Stripey Stork to resource your session appropriately, with a dedicated member of our team, who will guide your group throughout the session. It also provides vital income to support our operation and lifeline service.

This payment is due four weeks before your booking.

TERMS OF CANCELLATION



We understand that commitments can change. If you would like to reschedule your visit, we will do our best to accommodate your request, provided it is submitted at least four weeks before your original booking date and subject to the availability in our bookings calendar.



If you cancel your booking with less than four weeks' notice, our £500 invoice will still be due.
